## Living Choice Open 2 bowl Triples - Conditions of Play

1. The World Bowls Laws of the Sport of Bowls in Australian shall apply except as modified hereunder.
2. The Controlling Body is the Men's Bowling Club Match Committee which reserves the right to alter the advertised format in any way it considers necessary to bring the Carnival to a satisfactory conclusion. If rain stops or delays play the Match Committee reserves the right to determine on which end the game(s) shall be deemed to be completed.
3. Teams may be men, ladies or mixed.
4. There will be three (3) games of two (2) bowl triples, each game comprising ten (10) ends. There will be a one end roll-up before the first game only.
5. The event is NOT turnaround however the teams may change the playing order from each game. The order in which the team is played is at the team's total discretion.
6. There will be no dead ends. If the jack goes out of bounds, it is to be re-spotted on the centre line, either on or as near as possible to (a) the two-metre mark or (b) the end of the centre line chalk mark (or 'dot' if marked), at the discretion of the non- offending team.
7. A points system will be used to determine the winners. Three (3) points will be awarded for a game win. In the event of a drawn game teams will each be awarded $11 / 2$ points. One (1) point will be awarded for each end won and half $(1 / 2)$ a point for a tied end. (A drawn game is a "half win".)
8. The overall prize winners must have the most game wins and highest number of points awarded over the three (3) games. If teams are even on games and points awarded, count backs will be applied starting with, ends won, margins, least number of shots against, winner last end

10 No team can win more than one prize.
