

John Smith OAM Shield 2024

Welcome to the 2024 John Smith OAM Shield that is being contested by Zone 2 (Newcastle), Zone 6 (Hunter), Zone 10 (Sydney North West) and Zone 15 (Central Coast).

Each Zone is fielding a Senior Side of three teams of fours and an Open Side of three teams of fours.

Zone 10 thanks NBC Sports (Northmead), for hosting this prestigious event on the representative calendar.



Conditions of Play

1. Three (3) games of 21 ends (63 in total). To be a constituted game 54 ends must have been played

2. Timetable approximate:

a. Saturday

Game 1 starts at 10.00 am

Game 2 starts at 2.00 pm

b. Sunday

Game 3 starts at 9.00 am

3. The Host Zone's Side plays on the same green for all 3 games, but not on the same rinks.

4. Method of Scoring follows

BNSW COP

a. Side Win 7 Points (most total shots)

b. Side Tie (Draw) 3.5 Points (equal on shots)

c. Side Loss 0 Points (least total shots)

d. Team Win 1 Point (rink win)

e. Team Tie 0.5 Point (rink drawn)

Maximum 10 points scored in any match.

5. Determination of the Open and Senior Sides winners:

a. The side with the highest number of points, if equal then of those sides

b. The side with the highest total shots for and against, if equal then of those sides

c. The side with the least number of total shots against.

6. The overall winner is decided by the collective

points + margin of both the Open and Senior competition.

7. The host Club will be asked to announce its smoking policy prior to commencement of the event.

8. The event should preferably be held on grass greens because that is the most likely surface for the Inter-Zone Side
